

We have sent separately a letter containing the outline of the Shana Bet program we are planning to offer for the coming year. I am sure you will agree that it is a strong program, and that your son will grow immeasurably in the coming year.

This email is to discuss the finances and some of the other issues involved in returning for Shana Bet.

I.) Tuition

Tuition for Shana Bet is \$17,000. For those students who are only able to stay for the first semester (until January 15th, 2012), the tuition is \$10,000.

II.) Registration Fee

In order to plan for the coming year properly, it is critical that we know how many students are coming. Please help us by letting us know your plans well in advance, and by adhering to the deadline below.

Your signed Declaration Form (see attachment) and a \$1,000 registration fee must be submitted by July 1, 2011. After that date, we will not be able to guarantee a spot, although we will certainly make every effort to find a place for your son.

III.) Checks & Payment Schedule

We suggest the following payment schedule. If this does not work for you, please contact me to work out a separate payment schedule.

A.) Full year--\$17,000

- 1.) Registration--\$1,000 by July 1st
- 2.) Payment #1 \$3,500 August 1st
- 3.) Payment #2 \$3,500 August 15th
- 4.) Payment #3 \$3,000 September 1

- 5.) Payment #4 \$3,000 October 1
- 6.) Payment #5 \$3,000 November 1

B.) One semester--\$10,000

- 1.) Registration---\$1,000 by July 1st
- 2.) Payment #1 \$2,500 August 1st
- 3.) Payment #2 \$2,500 August 15th
- 4.) Payment #3 \$2,000 September 1
- 5.) Payment #4 \$2,000 October 1

If you choose to pay by wire transfer, please add an additional \$15 *per wire transfer*. Please contact Mrs. Edna Kwalwasser at: kwalwasser@msn.com regarding the specifics for making a wire transfer.

IV.) MASA Scholarships

Unfortunately, MASA Scholarships are given only once. Your son is not eligible this year for a MASA scholarship.

V.) Unpaid Tuition

In the event that your tuition from 10-11 has not been paid, **this balance must first be paid before you can register for Shana Bet.**

VI.) Medical Insurance

For the coming year, we are debating whether to continue offering coverage with the AIM Gold Plan, or to try another service. More information will be sent as a separate email.

VII.) Scholarship Policy

The Yeshiva is committed to help every Shana Aleph student to come back for Shana Bet. To this end, we provide scholarships to students who can demonstrate financial need. Priority is given to students who demonstrate real financial need, are staying for the entire year, and who can demonstrate that they have found other sources of funding. The Lev HaTorah scholarship form is available upon request.

You must submit your completed Lev HaTorah scholarship form, along with a letter explaining your circumstances, and appropriate documentation, to our office no later than July 1st, 2010, in order to be considered for a scholarship.

VIII.) Yearly Calendar

A complete calendar will be sent out in a separate email. The starting date for Shana Bet is **Thursday, September 1, 2010.**
